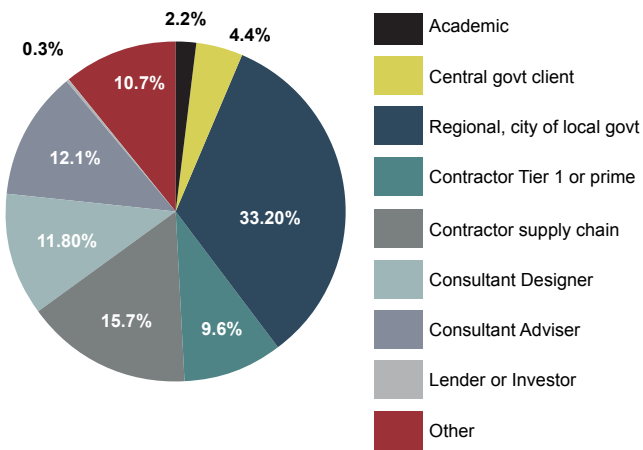
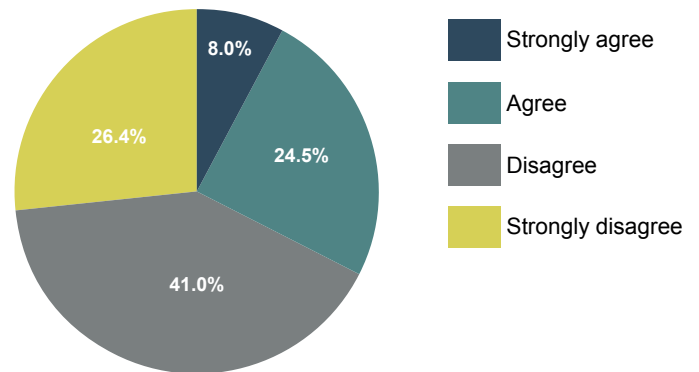

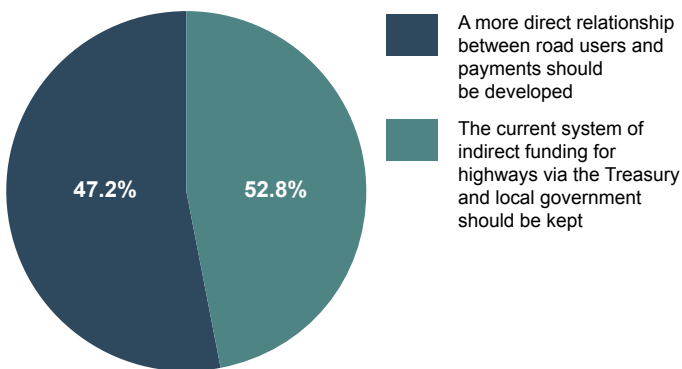
1. What part of the highways sector do you work in?



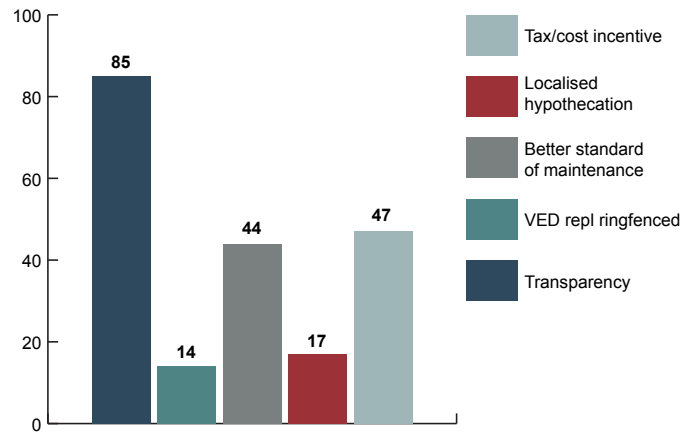
4. Please give your response to the following statement: The Government could implement road user charging without damaging public and business confidence in such a system.



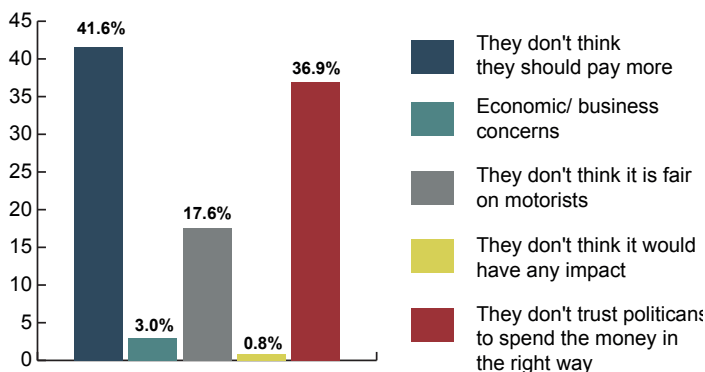
2. Which statement do you agree with more?



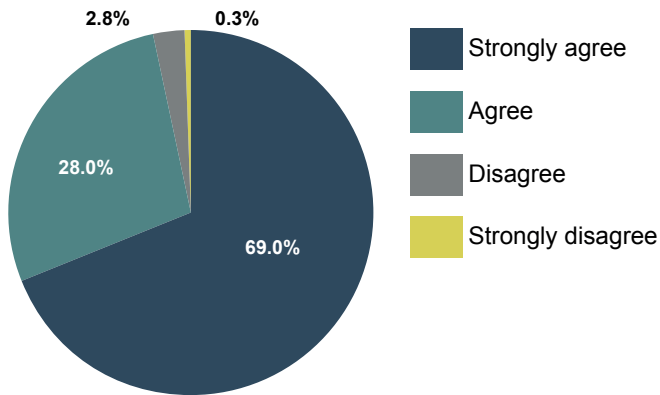

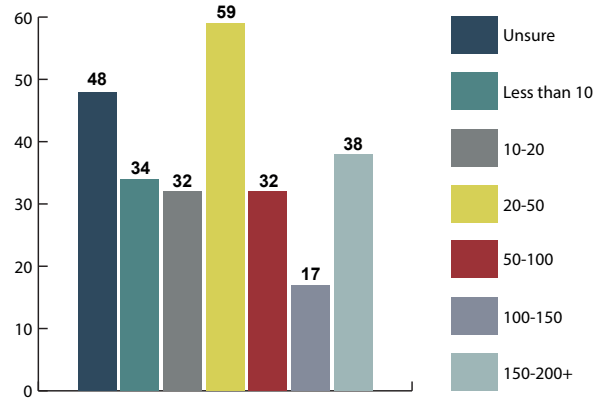

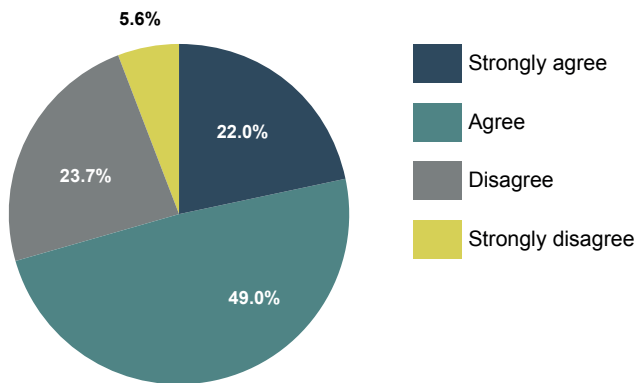
