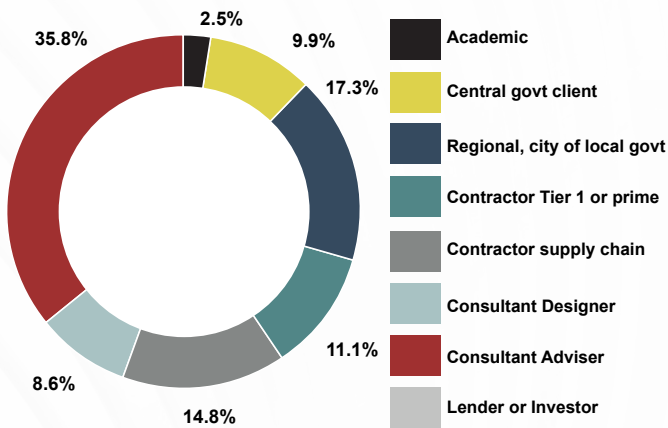


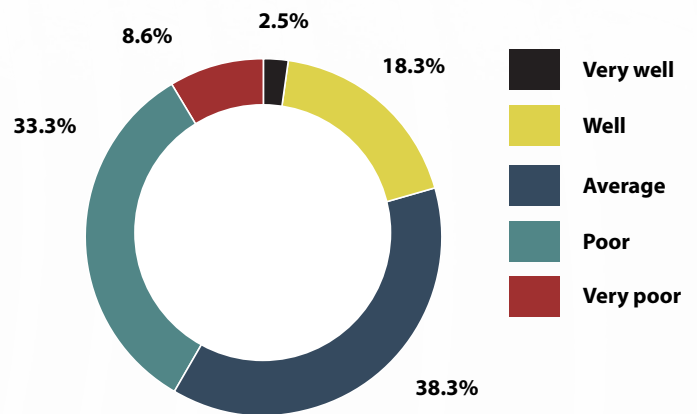
The FITZ INDEX Survey Results June 2018

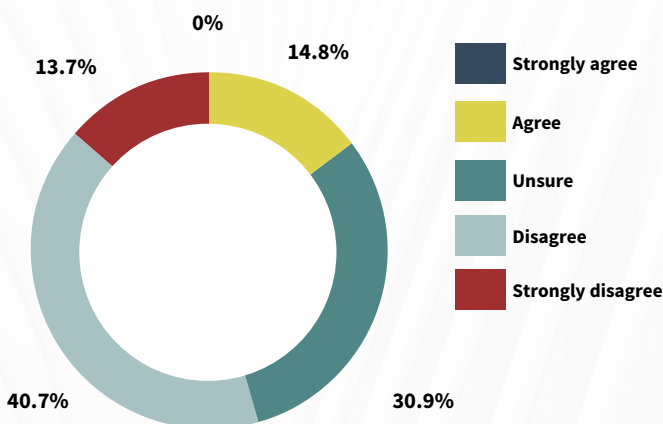
1. What part of the highways sector do you work in?



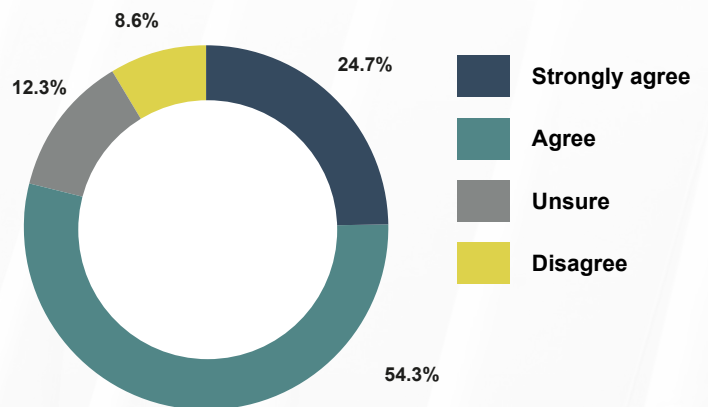
3. In general, how do you feel procurement practice in highways meets the needs of the sector?



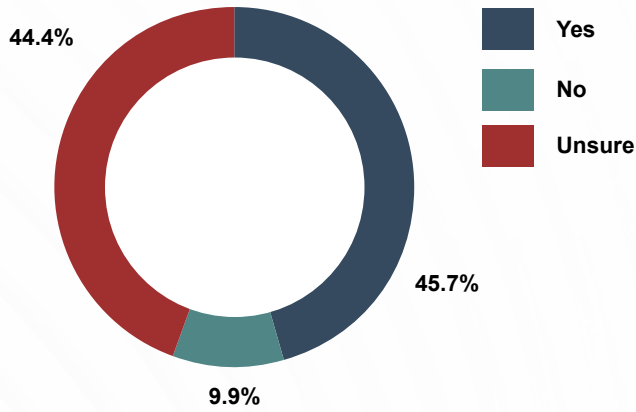
2. Is Procurement in the highways sector is fair for non-Tier 1 suppliers and for new entrants?



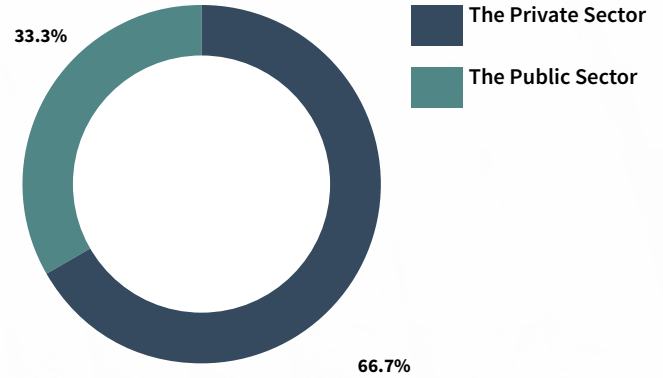
4. Highways procurement has, intentionally or otherwise, actually driven more risk averse behaviours from suppliers over the last five years.
